

# 2014-15 GM 1500 FULL SKID PACKAGE

**AWARNING** As a general rule, the taller a vehicle is, the easier it will roll. Seat belts and shoulder harnesses should be worn at all times. Avoid situations where a side rollover may occur. Generally, braking performance and capability are decreased when larger/heavier tires and wheels are used. Take this into consideration while driving. Do not add, alter, or fabricate any factory or after-market parts to increase vehicle height over the intended height of the Rough Country product purchased. Mixing component brands is not recommended.

9/16+socket/wrench

#### **Instructions**


- 1. Place the truck on a smooth level surface and set the parking brake.
- 2. Place the Lower Driver skid below the crossmembers and insert two of the 3/8+bolts and washers into the rear crossmember mounting holes. Hand tighten. See Photo 1.
- 3. Place the Lower Passenger skid on the passenger side below the crossmembers and insert two of the 3/8+bolts it the rear mounting holes. Next insert two of the 3/8+bolts, washers, and nuts into the center holes tying the driver and passenger skid plate together. Hand tighten. See Photo 2.





- 4. Hold the front crossmember into place and insert four of the 3/8+bolts and washers in the lower mounting location of the front skid plate. See Photo 3.
- 5. Next insert two of the 3/8+bolts and washers into the top mounting location. Now that all bolts are started you can go back and tighten each bolt with a 9/16+socket and wrench. See Photo 4.
